Prayer and Fasting Weekend: Beginning Saturday, January 26th at noon, we will begin our 24-hour period for the specific purpose of seeking the Lord. We don't do these things to gain His favor--we already have it! He can love us no more than he already loves us. It really is true! So we encourage any who can to take this time to join us to pray, fast, and seek the Lord. Along with taking one hour for specific praying, we want to encourage you to fast. 
